THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT

The Christian Manifesto - Matthew chapters 5 to 7

In the body of Christ's teaching known as *The Sermon on the Mount*, recorded in Matthew's gospel chapters five to seven, our Lord Jesus Christ declares his radical intent for those who dedicate themselves to follow him. The great ethical principles Christ sets forth and their potential for affecting the behaviour of those who are prepared to take them seriously is breathtaking.

They are not new "laws" but clear directions to be obeyed on the basis of grace. The only hope of fulfilling this teaching is through the power of the indwelling Spirit which those who are "in Christ" receive when they truly own him as Saviour and Lord. Because those who seek to take Christ seriously are still flawed and wounded, the full observance of Christ's teachings are not attainable possibilities this side of eternity.
